The waste is mainly liquid. But in some cases the solvents can evaporate in the process, during storage or other conditions so that what was originally liquid has now become sludge and partly solid. In the waste industry, w encounter waste that has not been handled or stored properly so that waste can appear that in its original form is liquid but which, based on the above, becomes solid when it arrives at our reception facilities.
